



ProWashroom Cleaning

Best practice guide

1

Spray a clean cloth with Cif Window & Multi Surface and polish all mirrors and shiny surfaces. Finish off with paper towel if needed for that streak-free shine.

2

Apply Cif 2in1 Washroom Cleaner on a damp cloth or a sponge and wipe away dirt and limescale from the hand sinks.

3

Rinse cloth with warm water, wring out and wipe down. Re-apply spray if necessary.

4

Remove built-up soap from bottom of soap dispensers and clean them with a damp cloth sprayed with Cif 2in1 Washroom Cleaner. Rinse the cloth in fresh water and wipe off surfaces.

5

Pull down the baby change unit.

6

Spray a cloth with Cif 2in1 Washroom Cleaner and wipe over all parts of the baby change unit. Rinse the cloth in fresh water and wipe off the surfaces with a damp cloth.

7

Spray the cloth with Cif 2in1 Washroom Cleaner and clean the straps.

8

Close the baby unit and wipe the outside with a cloth sprayed with Cif 2in1 Washroom Cleaner.

9

Flush the toilets and reduce the water level by dunking the toilet brush into the water several times.

10

Using Domestos Toilet Descaler, direct the nozzle under the toilet rim and squeeze over the surface. Leave for 5 minutes.

11

Brush around the bowl paying particular attention to the rim and below the water line.

12

Flush the toilet to rinse the brush.

13

Spray a cloth with Cif 2in1 Washroom Cleaner and clean all external parts of the toilet. Rinse the cloth in fresh water and wipe off the surfaces with a damp cloth. Don't forget the flush handle!

14

Using Domestos Toilet descaler, direct the nozzle under the urinal rim and squeeze evenly over the surface. Leave for 5 minutes.

15

Brush the inside of the urinal paying particular attention to the rim and centre.

16

Fill a mop bucket with warm water and add Cif 2in1 Washroom Cleaner according to the dilution rate.

17

Clean away debris before mopping all parts of the washroom floor and allow to air dry. Finish off by also wiping off the washroom door handle!
